### **Dentists Must Comply with ACA Section 1557**

Message from Dr. Summerhays, ADA President

You have likely heard the Office for Civil Rights has issued a final rule that prohibits health care entities that receive certain federal financial assistance from discriminating based on race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability. The rule went into effect on July 18 and implements Section 1557 of



the Affordable Care Act. It requires affected entities, like dental practices, to take steps such as providing meaningful access and effective communications for patients with limited English proficiency and/or disabilities. It also includes posting taglines and nondiscrimination notices in dental offices, on practice websites and in significant publications and communications by October 16.

Recognizing the burden that has been placed on members, and in view of unanswered questions about the final rule, the ADA sent a letter to the Office for Civil Rights requesting an extension of the implementation deadline. The letter also requested additional relief for smaller practices. The ADA had previously raised similar concerns, among other objections, when the rule was originally proposed last September, but the concerns did not appear to have been addressed in the final rule.

# Alliance for a Cavity-Free Future and Colgate Launch Grant Program

The Canada-United States chapter of the Alliance for a Cavity-Free Future announced a new grant program in August to help fund interprofessional projects that positively impact the oral health of pregnant women and children under 6. The annual grant program, backed by the Colgate-Palmolive Company, will award up to \$50,000 for selected projects.

The projects, according to a news release, "must focus on improving attitudes, knowledge and practices" related to the prevention of dental caries among children under the age of 6 and/or pregnant women within identified vulnerable populations including those from disadvantaged racial or ethnic minority groups or from regions with limited access to care.

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## **Notice: Membership Bylaws Vote on September 13**

#### Members to vote at the September Monthly Meeting on bylaws changes to allow mail and online balloting.

At the request of the DCDS Board, the Constitution and Bylaws Committee has drafted amendments to the Society's bylaws to allow eligible members the opportunity to vote by mail or online ballot. Currently, all DCDS members must appear in person to cast a ballot for contested Society leadership and ADA House of Delegate positions. The recommended changes to the bylaws strive to modernize the Society's voting process and give more members the opportunity to participate in the democratic process of electing officers and in deciding issues. The membership will be asked to approve these bylaw changes at the September 13<sup>th</sup> Monthly Meeting. #### Constitution and Bylaws Committee Recommend Updates to DCDS Bylaws

#### **13.0 CHAPTER XIII - NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS**

#### **13.10 PROCEDURE**

**13.11** Nominations for elections to any position or office with the exception of the President and General Chair of the NCDM shall be made at a designated business meeting and the election shall be held at a following appropriate announced meeting.

**13.11.1** An eligible member may vote by mail or online ballot, or any other means of electronic transmission approved by the Board of Directors.<sup>1</sup>

**13.12** All members of the Society must be notified at least two (2) weeks before the election of the names of the candidates nominated of the various elective offices and positions.

**13.13** A ballot sheet, when required for a contested election shall be printed made available with the names of the candidates nominated for the various elective offices and positions.<sup>2</sup>

#### **13.20 TIMES OF NOMINATION**

**13.21** Nominations for elective offices of the Society shall be made at a business meeting at least two months prior to any election.

**13.22** Nominations for delegates and alternate delegates to the American Dental Association House of Delegates shall be made at a regular business meeting immediately after the annual ADA House of Delegates meeting and at least two (2) months prior to the election. which will take place at a business meeting.<sup>3</sup>

### **Medicaid Electronic Health Records (EHR) Incentive Payment Program**

All dentists who serve DC Medicaid beneficiaries are eligible to receive an Electronic Health Records (EHR) incentive payment through the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program (MEIP). Dental practices that maintain at least 30% Medicaid patient volume can receive incentive payments for acquiring a <u>Meaningfully Using</u> (MU) Certified Electronic Health Record Technology (<u>CEHRT</u>). Up to \$63,750 is available to meaningfully use Electronic Health Records (EHRs). Nine out of ten dentists serving the District's Medicaid population have yet to avail themselves of this opportunity to leverage EHRs to improve population health and patient outcomes. Please visit the DC <u>State Level Registry</u> (SLR) for more information and to begin your Program Year 2015 attestation, accepted now through September 30, 2016.

In order to register for the incentive payment:

- 1. Register with CMS at <u>Medicare and Medicaid EHR Incentive Program</u>. Select "District of Columbia" as the state of attestation.
- 2. Verify your EHR system is <u>CMS-certified</u> at <u>EHR version for Adopt, Implement, and Upgrade (AIU)</u>.
- 3. Register with the <u>District's State Level Registry</u> for incentive payments.

This presentation will present an overview of relatively frequent emergencies and possible intervention strategies associated with the prevention of emergencies and with rescuing of patients. Because pharmacological management of pediatric (and other patients) appears to be increasing, emergency management of more frequent sedation emergencies, their prevention, and management will be discussed. Dr. Wilson's research interests include child behavior in the dental clinic, sedation for children, and electronic monitoring during sedation.
