DCDS continues to advocate for you to improve the staffing situation in DC. On November 20, several members of the DCDS board of directors and Public Policy Committee met with the Chair of the DC Council Committee on Health, Councilmember Vincent Gray. It was an extremely positive meeting. He offered his support to continue discussions to advance meaningful changes. Thank you to all who participated in the discussion and for your continued commitment to representing our members' interests.



"I have been working with Catholic Charities providing pro bono dental care to the needy for over 20 years. The program developed by the DCDS Foundation in collaboration with the CCHCN is exactly what I have been doing for all these years, but now instead of working with this program as an individual I am now doing it through the Foundation so that our presence in the community is visible. The program is well developed and easy to join.

When CCHCN sends me a patient, I treat them like a new paying patient in my practice. I take a Full Mouth series of radiographs and do thorough exam to ascertain what the individual needs. Sometimes I just treat the emergency and sometimes I deliver comprehensive care. The patient and in many cases the accompanying family members can't stop thanking me. Their genuine smiles alone are good enough pay for me. Many bring little tokens from their country some send beautiful notes while others just give a nod and a smile. 

## Md. senator shares inspiration for Medicaid dental coverage bill

Maryland State Sen. Malcolm Augustine said he was inspired to introduce a bill requiring adult dental coverage in the state's Medicaid program after visiting a free dental clinic at the University of Maryland and seeing the many people who did not have dental coverage, State of Reform reported. "My constituents shared with me how they could not afford the out-of-pocket dental care, [how] they suffered, and [how] they had long waited for this event," he said. "In retrospect, I noticed some of these folks had not smiled, and this was just wrong, simply wrong." Sen. Augustine's bill was enacted into law and takes effect in January. The <u>ADA</u> has advocated for higher Medicaid reimbursements for dental care and encouraged dentists to participate in the program.

#### Develop a strategic hiring plan to fill workforce openings
